Parish Share 2026

Our Parish Share for 2026 is £90,000, which contributes partly to clergy stipends and Diocese staffing costs including safeguarding. The Parish over the last 15-20 years has struggled paying its quota to the Diocese and anticipates that this year will be more challenging despite growth in attendance. This Parish has delivered much:

20% growth in Christmas attendance, on 2025 levels.

Supper Club in its outreach to young children and families.

Singing for Wellbeing.

Pastoral Friends Coffee Mornings and Lunches for fellowship and support.

Plans to reorder All Saints Church.

Building and sustaining excellent working relationships with the school.

Our new Family Together service, and the Together service in the school.

Strengthening our community links, e.g. residential care homes.

An innovative solution to mission and worship in Acol.

If you are currently giving regularly to the Church, may I thank you for your generosity, and if you would like to increase the amount each week or month that would be appreciated. Or, if you do not give regularly, you may wish to consider doing so.
